This is with reference to the increasing demand by citizens of South Indian States for signage and communication in local languages.

Given the fact that many citizens in South Indian States, including Karnataka, are conversant in their local mother tongue, I request you to consider a directive to all Public Sector Units (PSUs) and Central Government agencies in South Indian States to ensure that signage and communication is made available in respective local languages, in addition to English and Hindi.

This will be a step forward in getting citizens across the country more involved and engaged in programmes of the Central Government once this important issue is addressed. This is particularly the case for many of the new social security initiatives of this Government, like pension, insurance and Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), that could be more successful and effective if they are communicated in local languages.

I do believe your intervention on this issue will go a long way in meeting the natural expectations of citizens of South Indian States.
