Please refer to the issue of commemorating the victory at Kargil every year raised by you under Special Mention on 23rd July, 2009 in the Rajya Sabha.

- 2. After the Kargil operations in 1999, the Kargil Vijay Diwas was celebrated on 26th July in 2000 and 2001. A decision was then taken in 2001 by Service Hqrs. that to avoid repetition, only Vijay Diwas would be celebrated on 16th December every year.
- 3. However, this year, on the occasion of its 10th anniversary, the Victory at Kargil was celebrated in a grand manner at Dras. The Hon'ble Prime Minister also laid a wreath at Amar Jawan Jyoti at India Gate on 26th July, 2009 to remember the scarifies of the brave soldiers during the conflict.
- 4. The case for celebrating 'Kargil Diwas' every year is being considered in consultation with Service Hqrs.
