A three-pronged approach is required to be adopted against the malaise of Child Sexual Abuse - increased Accountability, better mechanisms for Prevention, and swifter Prosecution. We must adopt a zero-tolerance approach towards crimes against children.

To take this forward to a larger platform, I, together with several NGOs, key-stakeholders and institutions came together to form National Coalition to Protect Our Children (NCPOC) in the



year 2015 with the objective of helping the government frame policies that will ensure safety and well-being of children. I invite you to join the NCPOC and help strengthen our common fight to end the scourge of Child Sexual Abuse.

I have great confidence that your Bharat Yatra will be a resounding success. I support your efforts and wish you all the best for this important initiative and look forward to meeting you once you complete the Yatra.
