Honour Nambi with Padma award, MP urges Modi

Thiruvananthapuram: Rajeev Chandrashekar, MP, has urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to adequately reward former Isro scientist Nambi Narayanan for the humiliation he had faced after being wrongly accused of espionage.

In a letter written to the PM, Chandrashekar said, "The abuse and humiliation he faced cannot be restored alone by giving Rs 50 lakh."

He has urged the Centre to honour Narayanan with a Padma award or a similar recognition that acknowledges eventual triumph of good over evil.

Chandrashekar said the arrest of Narayanan had terrorised the entire Isro community, which seemed to have been the primary purpose of those who had manufactured this false case against him. This apathy and abuse meted out to an esteemed scientist by the then Congress government was shameful and unforgivable.
